The Department of Older Persons (DOP) is committed to administrating our organization with good governance, fostering an organizational culture of virtue, honesty, integrity, and transparency, preventing, and combating corruption and misconduct in all forms. We aim to build faith and trust in society that executives and personnel of DOP will perform our duties with righteousness and free from conflicts of interest and corruption.

With our strong commitment, DOP hereby announces that all government officials will refrain from accepting or offering any forms of gifts in connection with the performance of our duties. All executives and personnel of DOP shall not accept, not offer, any kind of gifts or other similar forms of reward related to the performance of duties (No Gift Policy) at any time—before, during, and after performing official duties—on all occasions and during all festivals. This is to prevent unfair and improper conduct that would lead to corruption and misconduct, both now and in the future. It also aims to cultivate correct values and attitudes, and to prevent conflicts between personal interests and the public interest. Executives and directors at all levels must set a good example and supervise all personnel under their command to conduct properly in accordance with relevant laws and regulations strictly going forward.
